NOTES

1. Membership (as opposed to Full Membership) was created to encourage use throughout the year of the social amenities which the Club offers. Thus the Committee is especially looking for Candidates, who living locally, will actively use these facilities; for those living further afield consideration of the time of travel to the Club will be borne in mind (this membership category was formally known as Associate Membership).
2. A candidate for election as a Member must have a Full (or Life Member) either as his Proposer or Secunder. The other Proposer or Secunder, may be a Member.
3. No rowing qualification is required for Membership, but rowing connections or interests should be listed under sporting interests. However Candidates are expected to be of 'good fellowship'. Membership is limited to 35% of the total Membership. As a result there may sometimes be a waiting list. When this occurs, priority is given to candidates who have rowed or been involved in the organisation of the sport and who reside in the Henley and the immediate Thames Valley area.
4. No minimum age limit is prescribed by the Rules but the Committee does not usually elect Associate Members below the age of Thirty.
5. A list of candidates will be posted in the Clubhouse at least seven days before an election and Proposal Forms will be available for inspection in the Office.
6. The above notes are for guidance only and do not necessarily form part of the Rules of the Club.
7. If guidance is required prior to an application for membership being submitted please contact the Honorary Secretary.
8. Candidates are assumed to agree that all information given be held on computer records for Club purposes only.
9. Membership does not confer a right to use the Club's boats or training facilities which may only be used with the express consent of the Captain.
10. A Member may also add a Spouse to his/her membership. Please contact the office for details.
