WELCOME TO LEANDER CLUB AT HENLEY ROYAL REGATTA 2023!

We have taken on board many of our Members' suggestions from last year's Regatta and we have made some important adjustments to bring you the best service and most convivial and relaxing atmosphere you'll find on the riverbank. In essence, this means more tables available for dining bookings, more bars in the garden to serve your drinks more quickly and the much loved afternoon tea, available in the Dining Room and the garden.

There will be a new structure at the rear of the garden which will become the 'Regatta Bar'. The riverside Deck Bar will have an additional bottle bar and a Pimm's bar where you will find Pimm's on tap!

There are new choices for casual food too, with the shack becoming the 'Regatta Café', serving cheese toasties, sandwiches and cakes. Prairie Fire return with their blend of Kansas City BBQ. Teas and coffees will be available all day.

For those looking for a private hospitality area, we are hosting a brand new Floating Bar which will be moored next to the athlete's pontoon on the river. You can book 'all day' tables with spectacular views and refreshments included, or take over the entire bar for a private party in the evening.

This year we will be selling meal tickets in two tranches, to try and give everyone a chance to purchase.


Saturday and Sunday BBQ - 7pm onwards

BARS & RELAXING

We have increased the number of bars in the garden to ensure you never go thirsty! There will be a new 'Regatta Bar' in the garden. The Deck Bar will now feature the main bar, a bottle bar and a Pimm's bar. Brand new to Leander Club and available for private hire is a Floating River Bar, which adjoins the athletes' landing stage.

Deck Bar | Pimm's Bar | Bottle Bar

The Deck Bar will be serving beers, wine and spirits. Inside, you'll also find a Pimm's Bar and a dedicated Bottle Bar.

Regatta Bar

A new bar, which will be inside the grounds on the right as you go through the main gate. Selling a range of draft beers, Pimm's, and other refreshments.

Cocktail Bar

Offering a delectable selection of cocktails, day and night.

Clubhouse Bar

The Clubhouse Bar is open day and night, every day.

Floating Bar (private hire)

A brand new private bar on the river. Book tables for the day (book online), or the whole bar for an evening (call the office on 01491 575782).

Teas and coffees

These will be available all day, every day; in the Clubhouse and the Regatta Café in the garden..

Decking

Our riverside decking will be set up as a Regatta viewing deck, with standing room only on the HRR side, and tables and easy chairs on the bridge side. Wheelchair accessible and shaded with parasols.

Lawn

Seating will be set up here for relaxing, with a mix of low and high tables. Wheelchair accessible.

Crew Viewing Deck

A viewing deck with high seating will be set up alongside the Clubhouse hard standing, so you can (loudly) cheer the athletes as they go to race and return from the water.

Marquee

The marquee will be available for casual drinking and dining every evening.

Regatta Bar

Seating will be available here under parasols.

MUSIC

Live music Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights!

After the huge success of last year's music, we've invited Bloc OffThe Wall to perform again from 8pm-10:30pm from Friday to Sunday. There will no longer be a big stage in the garden, but a much smaller and more discrete stage facing away from the deck inside the marquee.

WINNERS' PARTY

Members are invited to the winners' party on Sunday night from 6pm. Members and those with guest badges will not need tickets. A limited number of non-Member tickets will be available from the Badge Tent throughout the week for competing crews only.

Winners enter free on presentation of their medals.

Bloc off the Wall will be providing the music. Food will be available from Prairie Fire BBQ.

Maximum booking is for tables of 10 outside and up to six inside, unless discussed with the office on 01491 5757782. Smaller parties may be placed on shared tables. Members may book only one lunch table per day. Dinners and teas are unlimited.

Afternoon teas are sold by ticket, rather than table.

For large dinner bookings, private hire of the new floating river bar, or breakfast bookings, please call the office on 01491 575782. These are available to book immediately.

ON THE DAY

If you are dining at Leander or taking a boat trip, report to the Badge Tent as you arrive to collect extra guest passes or boat tickets.

Members booking a meal will receive an extra swing badge for every guest over and above their daily allocation of the two guest passes included in this pack (please remember to bring these). Report to the Badge Tent to collect your complimentary extra guest badges for your pre-booked meals on arrival.

GUEST BADGES

Extra day guest badges can be purchased for £17. Pre-book by contacting the office on 01491 575782. A limited number will be available at the Badge Tent on the day.

Members are reminded they are responsible for their guests at all times.

DRESS CODE

All Members are asked to remind their guests that the dress code for Regatta is very traditional. These dress codes apply to everyone and no exceptions are made.

The Leander Dress Code during Regatta is the same as the Dress Code for the Stewards' Enclosure. Gentlemen are required to wear lounge suits, or jackets or blazers with trousers, together with a tie or, if preferred, a cravat. Ladies are required to wear dresses or skirts, with a hemline below the knee, or jackets or blazers with trousers, or trouser suits. No one will be admitted to Leander or the Stewards' Enclosure wearing shorts, leggings, tracksuits or jeans.

CHILDREN

Children over the age of 10 are welcomed provided they comply with the adult dress code. Younger children and babies will not be allowed entry before the end of racing on Sunday.
