President: Richard Lester (Joined 2022)

Won Thames and Grand for Leander in 1970 and 1975 respectively. 1976 Olympic silver stroking GB eight in Montreal. Commercial property lawyer currently a Consultant at Wedlake Bell LLP in the City. Has acted for ARA, Sport England and other sporting organisations. A Henley Royal Regatta Steward since 1979 and on the Committee of Management for much of that time. A Governor of Shiplake College. Chairman, and founder, of Leander Investment Club.

Chairman: Pete Bridge (Joined in 2019)

Oxford Blue and GB International, competing in the 1996 Olympics. Rowed for Leander for six years in the 1990s and won two Henley medals for the club. Was chairman of Oxford University Boat Club for 10 years until 2018 and umpired the Boat Race prior to that. Formerly a lawyer and management consultant, now a banker with Barclays Bank in London.

Hon. Treasurer: Justin Hodges (Joined 2020)

Justin rowed for Isis twice and the GB U23s as well as Leander in the Wyfolds. He started his career at Goldman Sachs International before moving to Vodafone. He is currently the Bursar at Abingdon School.

Barbara has been involved in the sport for more than 35 years. She began rowing at City of Oxford Rowing Club and quickly became involved with the club committee and the regatta.
